Good morning everyone.

Today is Thursday the 3rd of June.

I am very disappointed to hear that we will be learning from home for another week. But as we discussed before, the purpose for everyone to stay home is to ensure everyone is kept safe. And we are not doing it alone, it's happening all over the world. For example, my niece Cheng-Cheng, who lives in Taiwan has been staying home for the past two weeks. Do you have any relatives in other countries who are doing remote learning just like you now? Have a little discussion with your parents.

I would like you to think of the advantages and disadvantages of home learning. That is, the good and bad aspects of home learning. I would like you to make a recording of it and send it to me.

When you send the recording through, please ask your parents to let me know if you would like to share your recording in the sharing/news page on Wix.

A reminder too, you may send me a recording of any news you have. For example, the tepee or ladder you've been building, the x-ray you have taken, and so on.

For today's session, you'll need: your practice book, your big orange ML book and your crayon bag.

Word Search

We will be working on a number wordsearch today. [See pic 1.](#)

We have been working on the 5 x 5 grid in the classroom. Today's wordsearch however has 6 x 5 grid.

Copy the entire wordsearch into your practice book, and circle the number words.

You may pause the recording now, or keep on listening and do everything once you have finished listening to the recording.

Uncover my number.

For today's uncover my number, please work out: 'Jess had 17 marbles. Tess gave her some more marbles and then she had 28 altogether. How many marbles did Tess give to Jess? You may use any counter available in the house to help you. Check the answer with your parents once you're done. ($17 + 11 = 28$, $28 - 17 = 11$)

You may pause the recording now.

Main Lesson

For writing today, we will be writing "*The unhappy Loolo turned into a blue fish. He was unfortunately eaten by a big fish.*" A reminder, can everyone please mark your golden pathway neat and straight. Pay attention to the formation of your letters. They should be from the top to the bottom, from left to right. Check your pencil grip, use blue coloured pencil for the naming words. Lastly, remember to mark the page number 6.

You may pause the recording now.

Yesterday, you listened to the story of 'The Topknot Pigeon'. Please review/summarise the story to your parents. Alternatively, you may review the story quietly to yourself. You may do so now and pause the recording.

For today's drawing, we will be drawing 'The Topknot Pigeon' into page 6 of your ML book. You may pause the recording now and draw.

Thanks for those of you who had made the beeswax yesterday, I enjoyed them very much. Some of them can be viewed on the Gallery Walk page on Wix. Well done!

You have one additional task today, that is, to contact your partner for the Word Family session tomorrow. It is important for you to contact your partner so that you may do the group work tomorrow. Please show your good manners when you talk to your friend.

I have assigned you into groups of two, and the contact details have been emailed to your parents.

The Extras are important. Make sure you continue to work on your weaving if you have not finished. You must practise recorder every day. The addition/subtraction worksheets have to be completed by everyone by the end of this week. With the subtraction, a reminder that you may add up two rolls of dice then use that sum to take away the third roll.
