Good morning class 2.

Today is Wednesday the 9th of June.

There are two sessions today. Firstly, the usual Main Lesson work and secondly, the snowman addition-memory game. Once you have completed the Main Lesson work, please take a break, then find a time to work through the snowman memory game.

For now, you'll need: your practice book, your big orange ML book and your crayon bag.

Number word search:

This number word search is a 6 x 6 grid and contains four words. They are: five, eight, nine, ten and eleven, and are written at the bottom. Some words reappear many times. They are hidden vertically, horizontally and diagonally. Copy everything into your practice book. And see how many words you spot. **See pic 1.** You may pause the recording now, or keep on listening and do everything once you have finished listening to the recording.

Uncover my number:

For today's uncover my number, please work out: 'I found a dozen of eggs in the chook pen, dad cooked 4 on the BBQ. Mum used 2 for a cake. How many eggs left?' You may use any counter available in the house to help you. Check the answer with your parents once you're done. ($12 - 4 - 2 = 6$)

You may pause the recording now.

Main Lesson

For writing today, we will be writing: '*A parrot helped the little bird. Then the colours of rainbow poured over the little bird.*' Please write these sentences into **page 14.**

You may pause the recording and write now.

Yesterday, you listened to the story of 'How kangaroos got their tails.' Please review/summarise the story to your parents. Alternatively, you may review the story quietly to yourself. **You may do so now and pause the recording.**

Many of you are going to use the last page of this book, and tomorrow we will be working on the cover page that we left blank two weeks ago. I'll let you know what to do tomorrow.

For the last picture of this book, we will be drawing 'How the kangaroos got their tails' into **page 15** of your ML book. **You may pause the recording now and draw.**

Your additional task today is to play a game of snowman memory cards with your family. Please:

- Cut them out, shuffle cards.
- Turn all cards face down.
- Pick one card up and either say the number or the sum for the math fact.
- Pick up another card.
- If the sum and math sentence match up, keep the match.
- If the sum and the sentence don't match, put the cards back and move to the next player

Task List:

1. Number wordsearch.
2. Uncover My number: 'I found a dozen of eggs in the chook pen, dad cooked 4 on the BBQ. Mum used 2 for a cake. How many eggs left?'
3. Writing: 'A parrot helped the little bird. Then the colours of rainbow poured over the little bird.' On page 14.
4. Review/Summarise the story: *How the kangaroos got their tails.*
